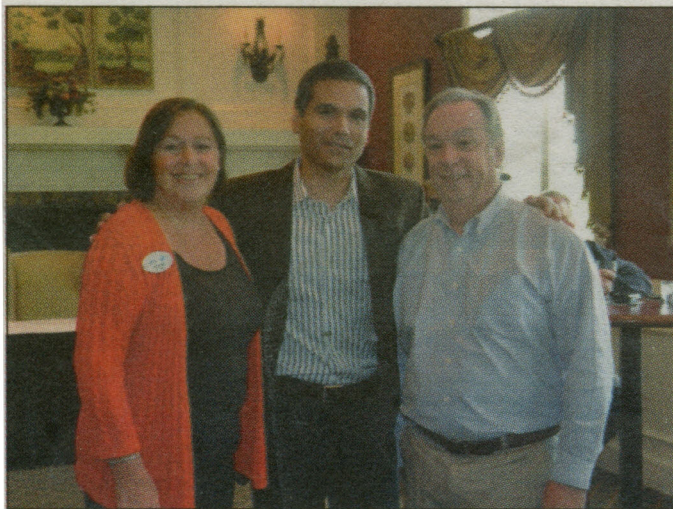

## Dottie's House Golf Classic Raises Over \$70,000
